Fee for Unauthorized Actions (damage, theft, etc) <i>Including, but not limited to, cutting locks; turning the valve on the District's side of the meter; tampering with meter; theft of water; etcetera</i>	\$500.00 not to exceed \$4,000.00 fine also includes the actual costs for all labor, material, equipment, and other actions necessary to correct service diversions, unauthorized taps, or reconnection of service without authorization. There may also be an average water usage charged based on the highest usage month in the past 5 years added for each month the unauthorized action has disrupted the District's facilities or equipment has been damaged by tampering, by-passing, installing unauthorized taps, reconnecting service without authority or other service diversions. All components of this fee will be itemized, and a statement shall be provided to the Customer. If the District's facilities or equipment have been tampered with or damaged due to unauthorized use of the District's equipment, easements, or meter shut-off valve, or due to other unauthorized acts by the Customer for which the District incurs losses or damages, the Customer shall be liable for all labor and material charges incurred as a result of said acts or negligence. Note: Payment of this fee will not preclude the District from requesting appropriate criminal prosecution
